URACAN STAKES ADDITIONAL CLAIMS AND MAKES FINAL PAYMENT TO OBTAIN 100% INTEREST IN NORTH SHORE PROPERTY, QUEBEC

Vancouver, Canada – Uracan Resources Ltd. (the "Company") is pleased to announce that it has made the final payment of \$1,000,000 to Sheridan Platinum Group Ltd. (the "Vendor") to obtain an undivided 100% interest in the 903 square kilometre North Shore Property, subject to a net smelter royalty retained by the Vendor as previously disclosed.

In addition the Company is pleased to announce that it has staked additional claims in the North Shore Property area. An airborne geophysics and radiometrics program was completed during the summer of 2007 over the north-eastern portion of the claim group. Numerous new large uranium anomalies have been outlined in this radiometric survey, several of which extended beyond the existing property boundaries. Approximately 175 square kilometres of new claims have been staked to cover these areas of potential uranium mineralization lying outside the previously existing claim boundaries. The current total surface area covered by the old and new claims comprising the North Shore Property is approximately 1,075 square kilometres. Further work is planned during 2008 to evaluate the uranium anomalies outlined in these newly staked areas.
